Stay on marked trails. Trail markers enroute indicate permitted uses (i.e. hiking, biking and/or horses).

For the safety and enjoyment of other park users and park wildlife - **All dogs must be leashed.**

Motorized vehicles are not permitted.

Off trail travel, rock climbing and scrambling near the Falls, and in the Credit River gorge, are prohibited activities.

Camping and fires are prohibited.

Application must be made for any environmental studies, research or filming in the park. Contact the Park Superintendent.
